

Minutes of Sine Die adjourned meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bogota held on Thursday, January 3, 2019 at 7:15PM at the Bogota Senior Citizen Center.

Roll Call: Mayor Kelemen and Council members Fede, Gates-Ferris, Macfarlane, Miranda, Murphy, and Napolitano were present.

Motion was made by Councilman Napolitano, seconded by Councilwoman Fede, to open the meeting to Citizen Remarks. Motion carried.
