BOGOTA 2018 TONNAGE GRANT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act PL 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2018 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of Bogota to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Bogota endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Joseph Scarpa to ensure the application is properly filed along with the BCUA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

**PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SUBMISSION OF A 2019 BERGEN COUNTY
TRUST FUND GRANT APPLICATION**

Application of the Borough of Bogota for Bergen County Trust Fund Municipal Program for Park Development grant funding for 2019.

TAKE NOTICE: that the Borough of Bogota will hold a Public Hearing on submitting the following application to the 2019 funding round of the Bergen County Trust Fund Municipal Program for Park Development:

- Fireman's Park Block 72.01, Lot 1, and Block 72.01, Lot 2, 246 River Road
- The Borough of Bogota desires to improve the Fireman's Park facility by installing a walking labyrinth meditation circle consisting of installation of concentric circles built with brick pavers. Two park benches are to be installed along with landscaping around the existing monument. In addition, a 4-sided clock is to be installed commemorating the 125th anniversary of Bogota.
